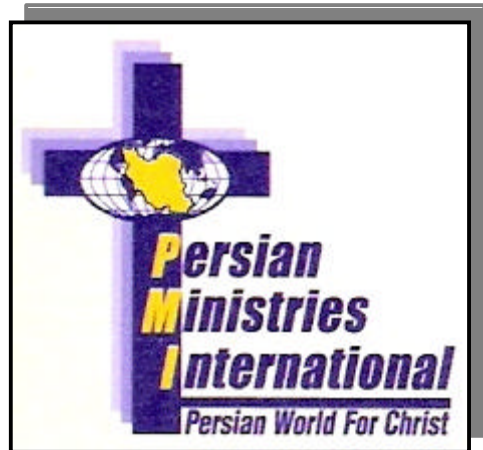


About Persian Ministries International (PMI)
